Created and directed by Ailie Cohen and Guy Hollands, Museum of Dreams will take place in a special performance space and transport audiences to a world of dreams through live physical performance, puppetry and projection. This production is performed entirely without words.

Recommended for school groups, families and children aged 6-8 years.

Running time:	45 mins
Touring company:	2 performers and 3 stage managers
Staging:	TAG has created a bespoke performance space for Museum of Dreams. We will bring a structure that we will erect within a large room. We require a large room – see below for size – in any appropriate and accessible building. <u>Not suitable</u> for a traditional stage layout.
Scale:	Suit medium/large flexible spaces. Please note that the maximum audience size is 40 people.
Technical requirements:	Minimum room requirements 15m x 12m. Height of structure: 4.2m (ideally 4.5m for clearance). Power requirements are one 32 amp single phase outlet. Room must be flat, clear of obstructions, have emergency lighting and the ability to be blacked out if there are windows. Minimum get in door is 12m x 1.6m (large double door).
